Rule 10 – Penalty Enforcements, Special Enforcements, All-But-One

What is your role/mechanic during penalty administration?

Rule 7 – Formations, fumble vs backward pass, illegal forward pass, DPI vs OPI

Who is eligible? Know your formation signals. Who punches forward/backward? What are the categories for PI?

August 7 – (Small Group)

Rule 3 – Starting/stopping the clock, 3-minute warm-up, between periods, timeouts

Who is watching the clock? What are you doing during halftime? What do you do during timeouts? Who is responsible for starting/stopping the clock?

Rule 4 – Dead ball officiating, out of bounds plays

When the play is dead, what are you doing? What are you watching? Sideline management: controlling your sideline, officials box, catch on sideline

Rule 6 – Free kicks, scrimmage kicks, field goals/extra points, fair catch

Who is your key? What are you watching? What are you doing after a score/extra point? Where are you supposed to be during a kicking situation?

Rule 5 – Downs, measurements

Who is responsible for the downs? What happens if we lose a down? What is your role in measurements?

Rule 8 – Scoring Plays, touchback vs safety

What is your role on a scoring play? What is force?

What are your pre-game mechanics? What are you looking for pre-game? What number does a play need to lineup in a certain position and what can they do/not do? (Can #57 be the fullback? Any restrictions? Can #25 be the center? Any restrictions)
